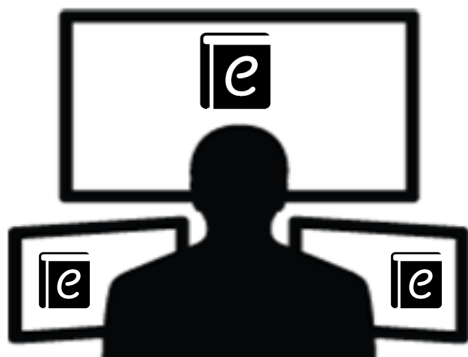
Dallastown Area Intermediate School Summer Reading Challenge 2019
